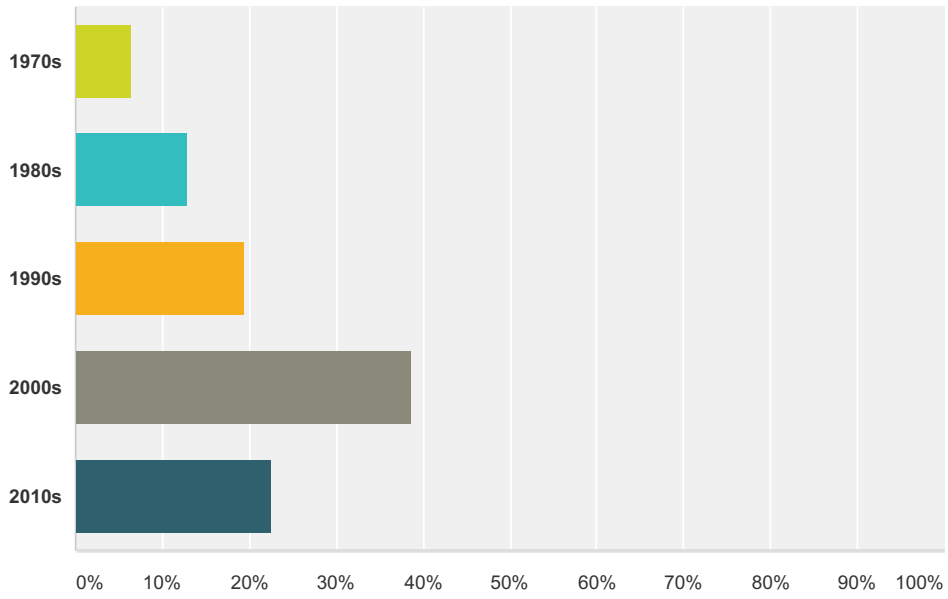


Q1 When Did you Graduate?

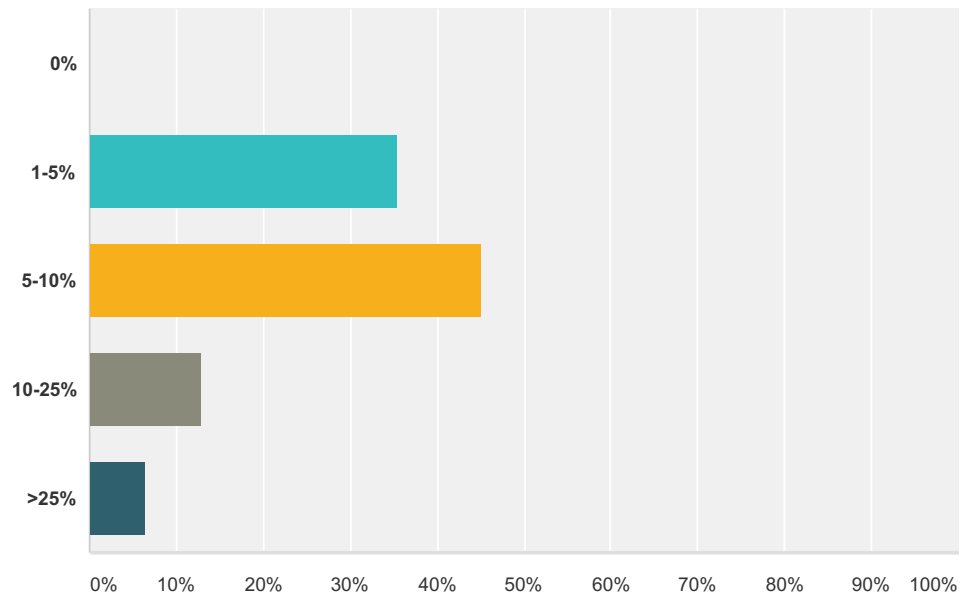

Q2 What percentage of you time is devoted to Small Ruminant work?

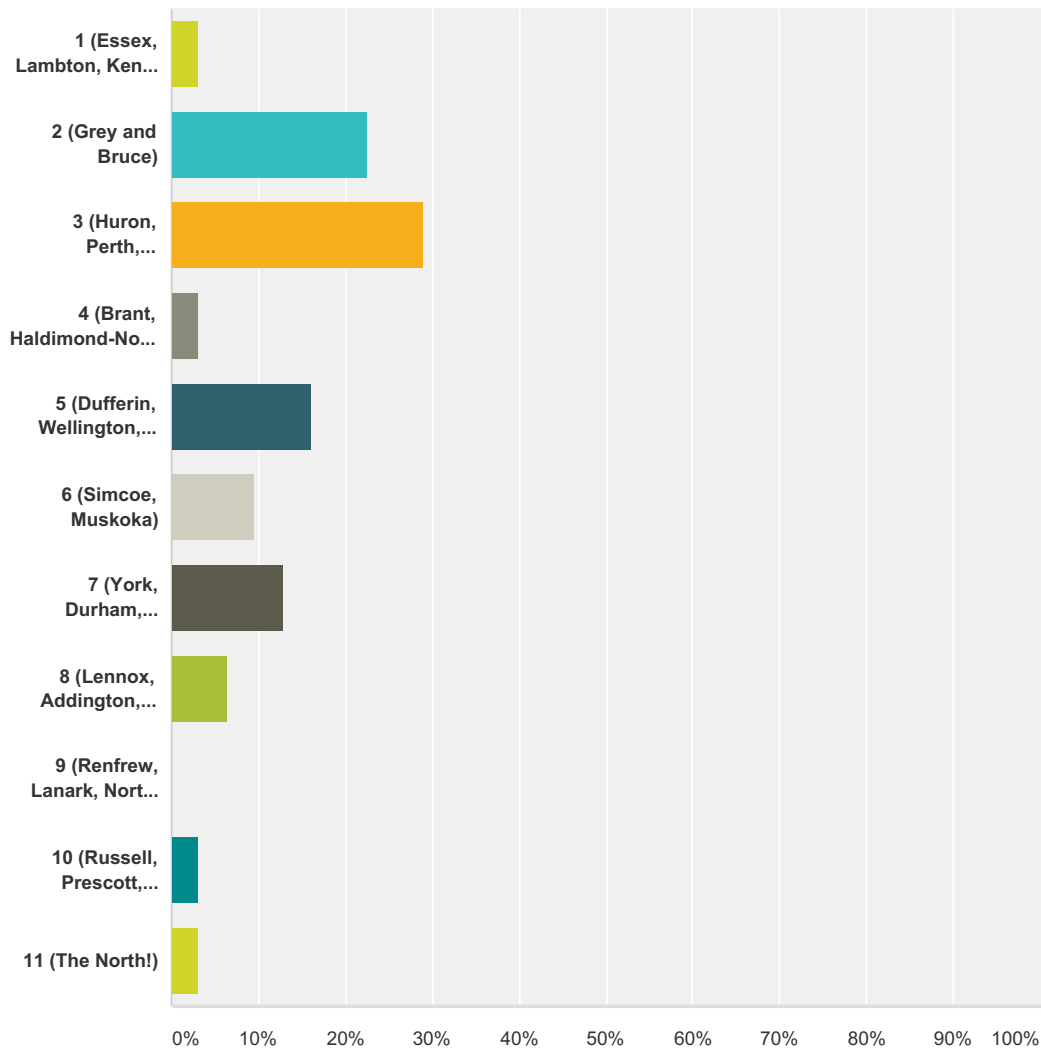

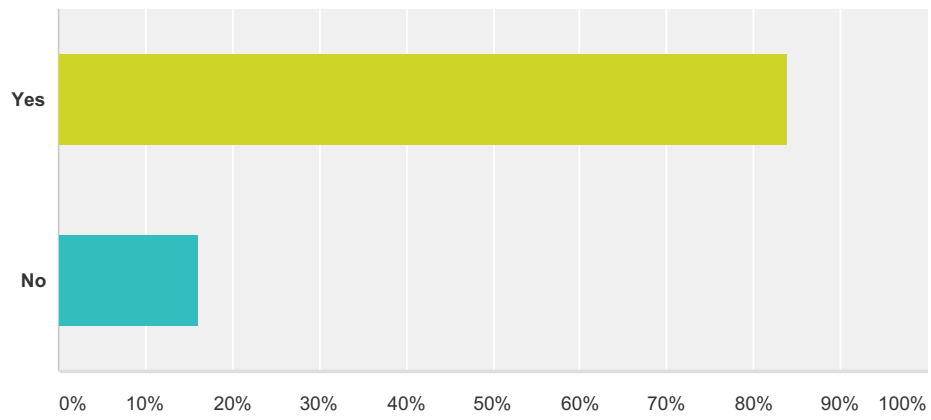

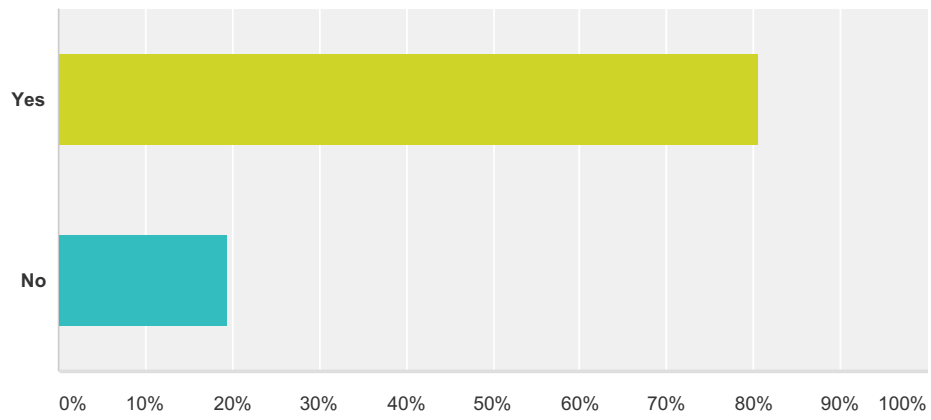

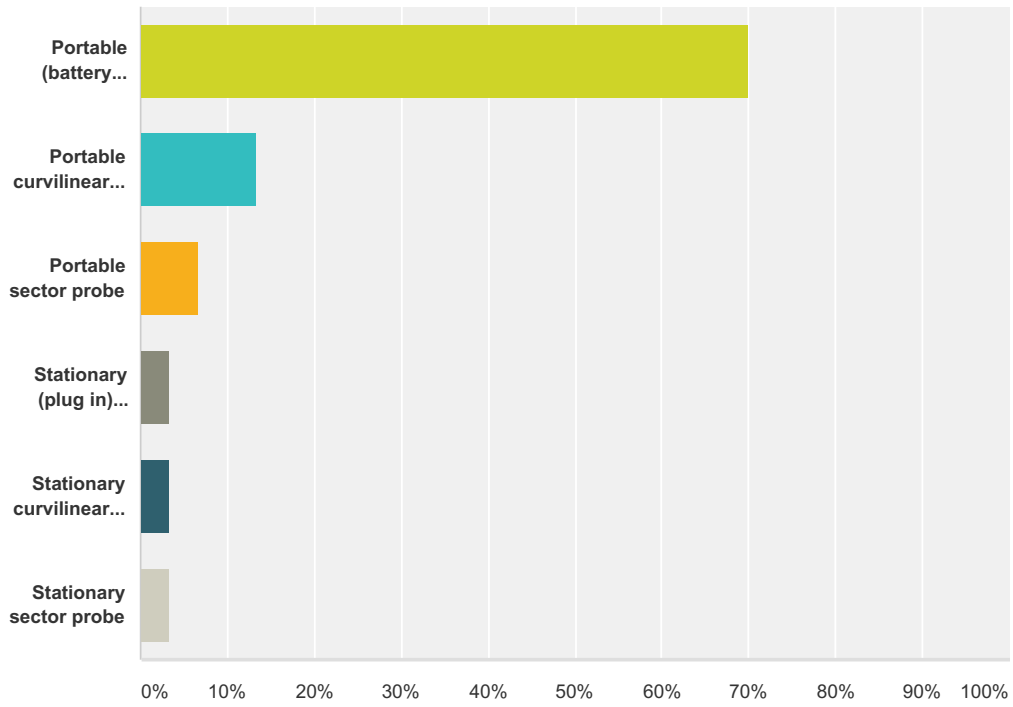

Q6 What Kind of ultrasound do you use?

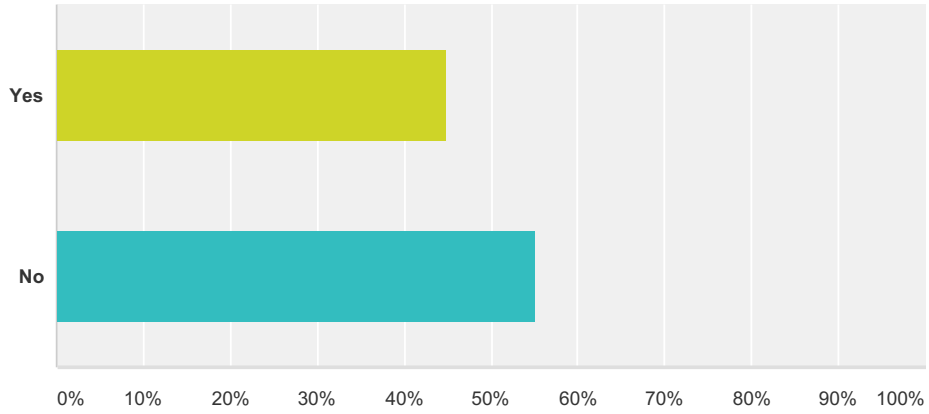

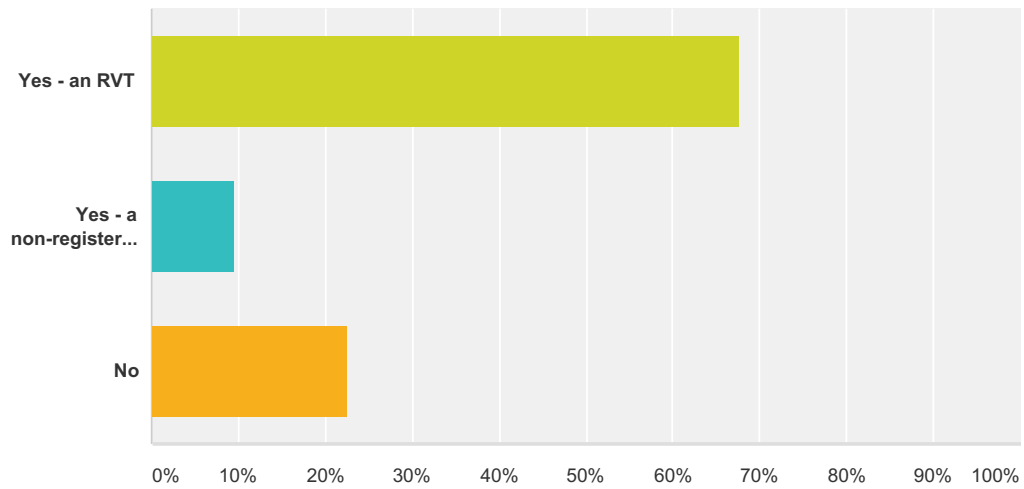

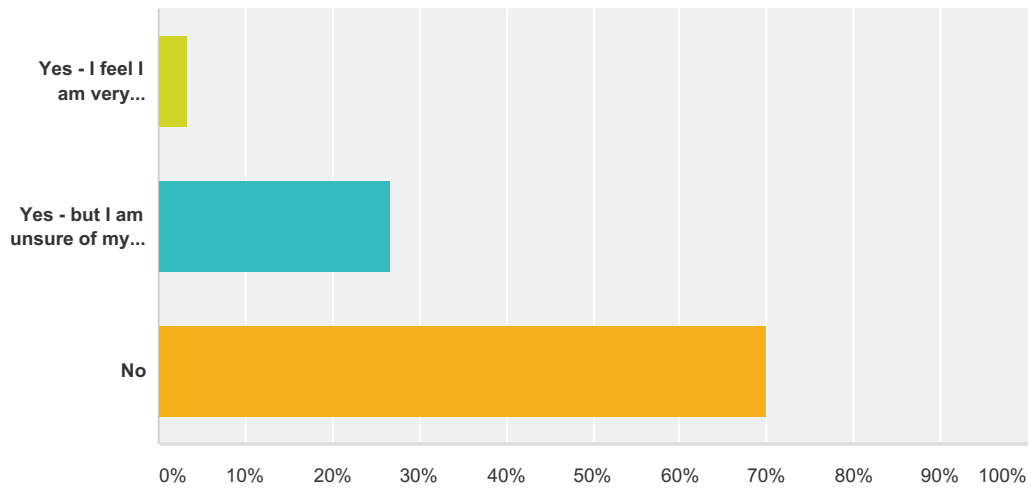

Q9 Do you offer fetal counting as part of your pregnancy Diagnosis?

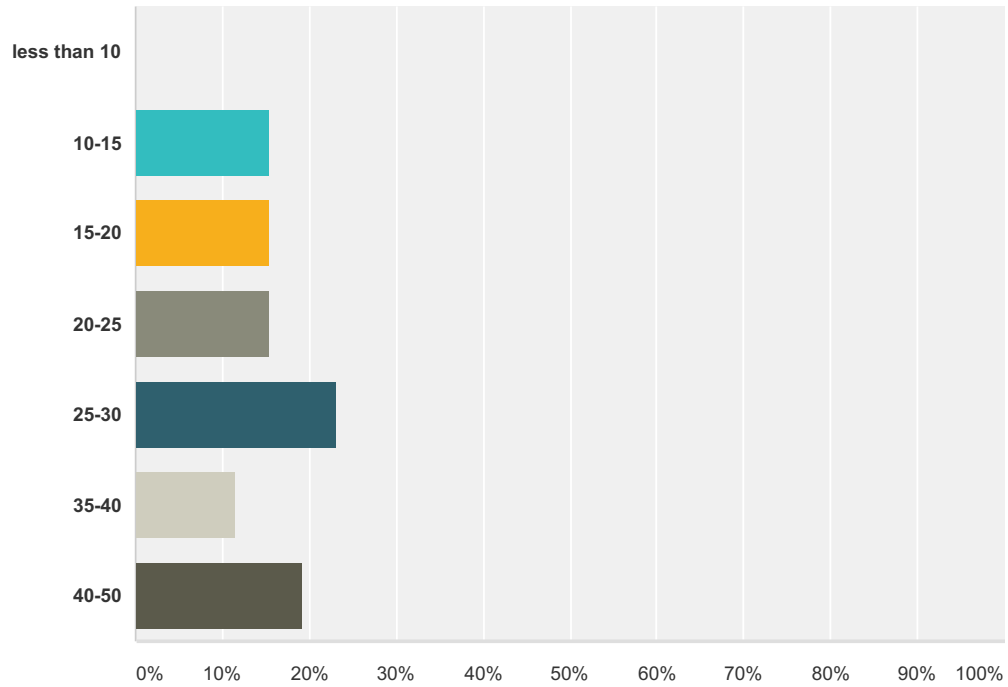

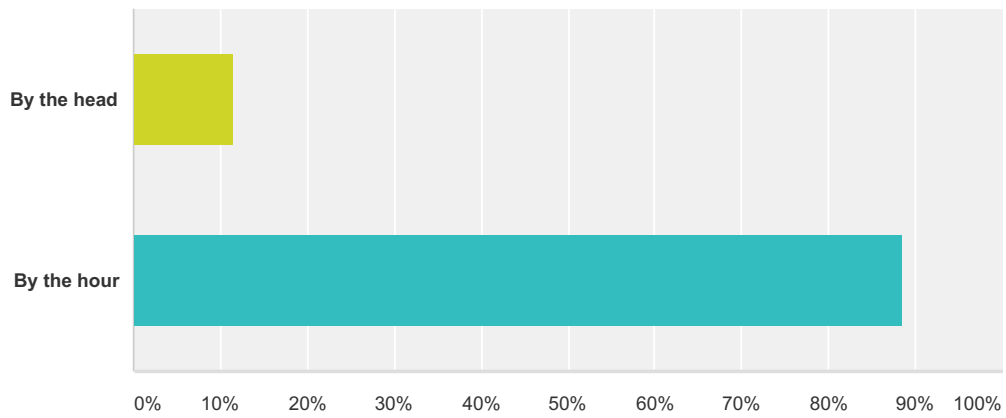

Q11 How do you charge for pregnancy diagnosis?

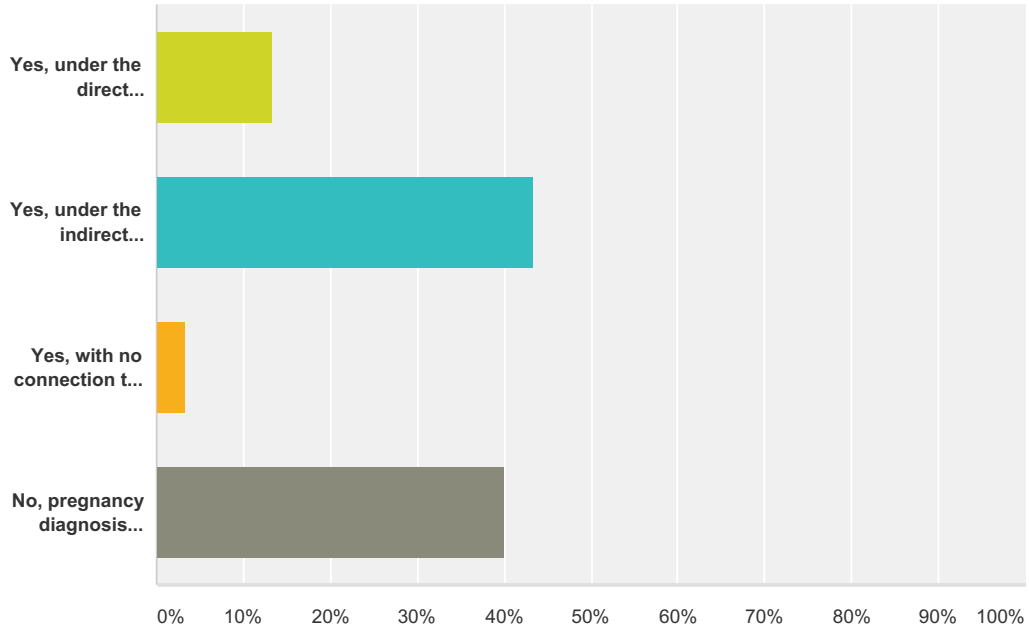

Q12 Do you think Technicians should be allowed to diagnosis pregnancy via transabdominal ultrasound in small ruminants?

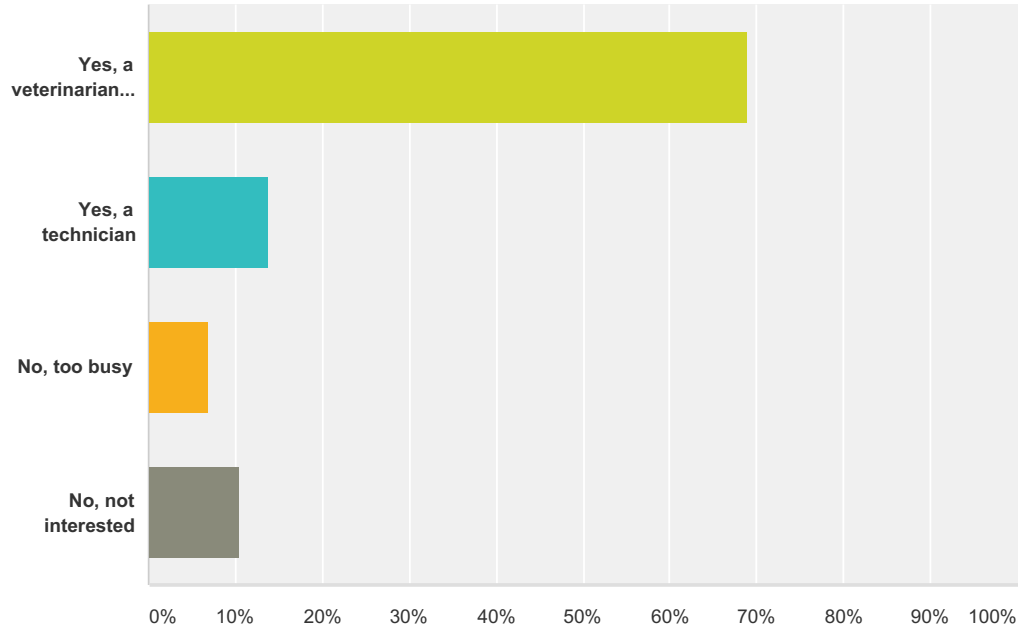

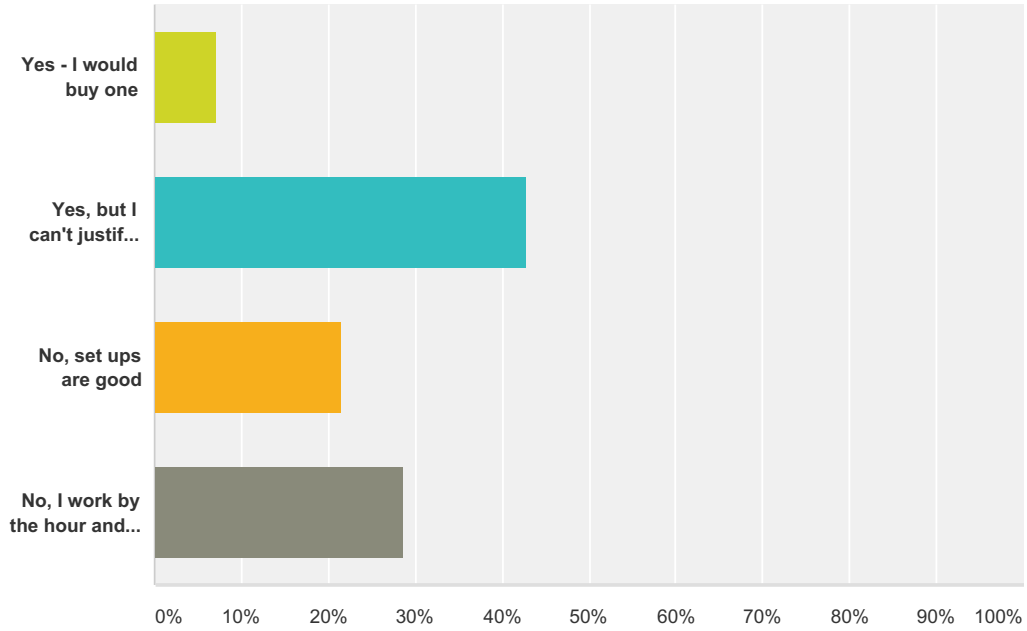

Q14 Would a portable chute assist you to perform pregnancy diagnosis more efficiently?

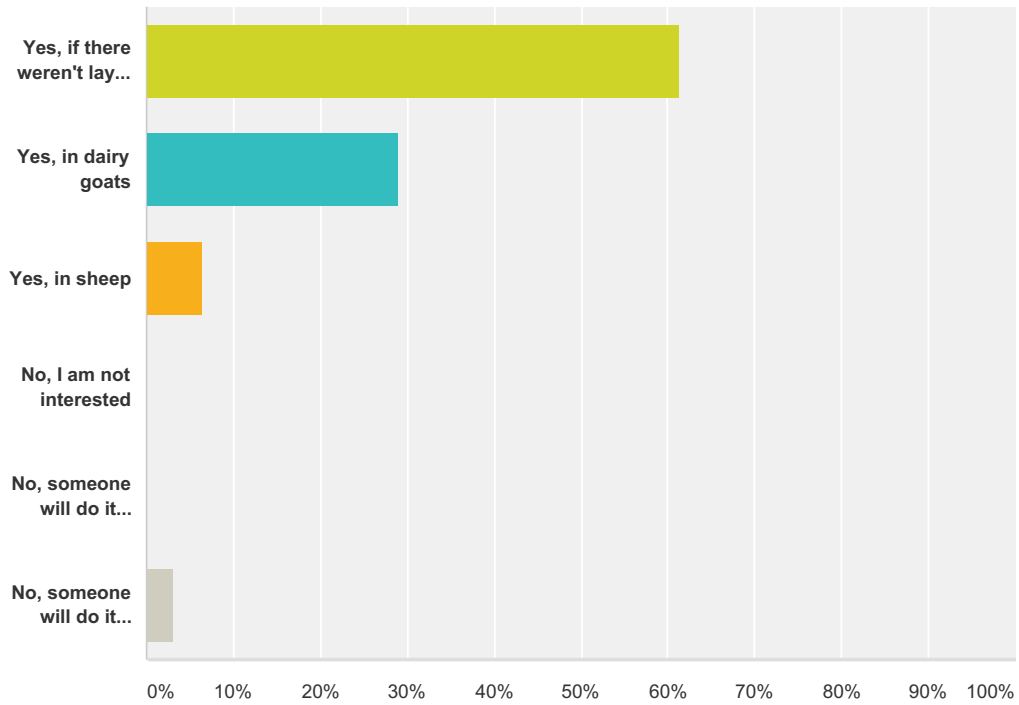
